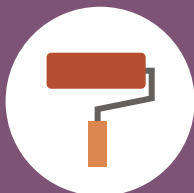

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Measuring what matters

Measurement at Ranyaka is designed to support decision-making in complex places, not simply to count activity.

We use shared measurement to establish a common baseline, identify system leverage points, guide the sequencing of action and investment and enable continuous learning over time.

Evidence is gathered through participatory, place-based surveys and system assessments, using a consistent set of indicators across people, place, economy and social cohesion and tracked over multiple years to identify patterns rather than isolate projects.

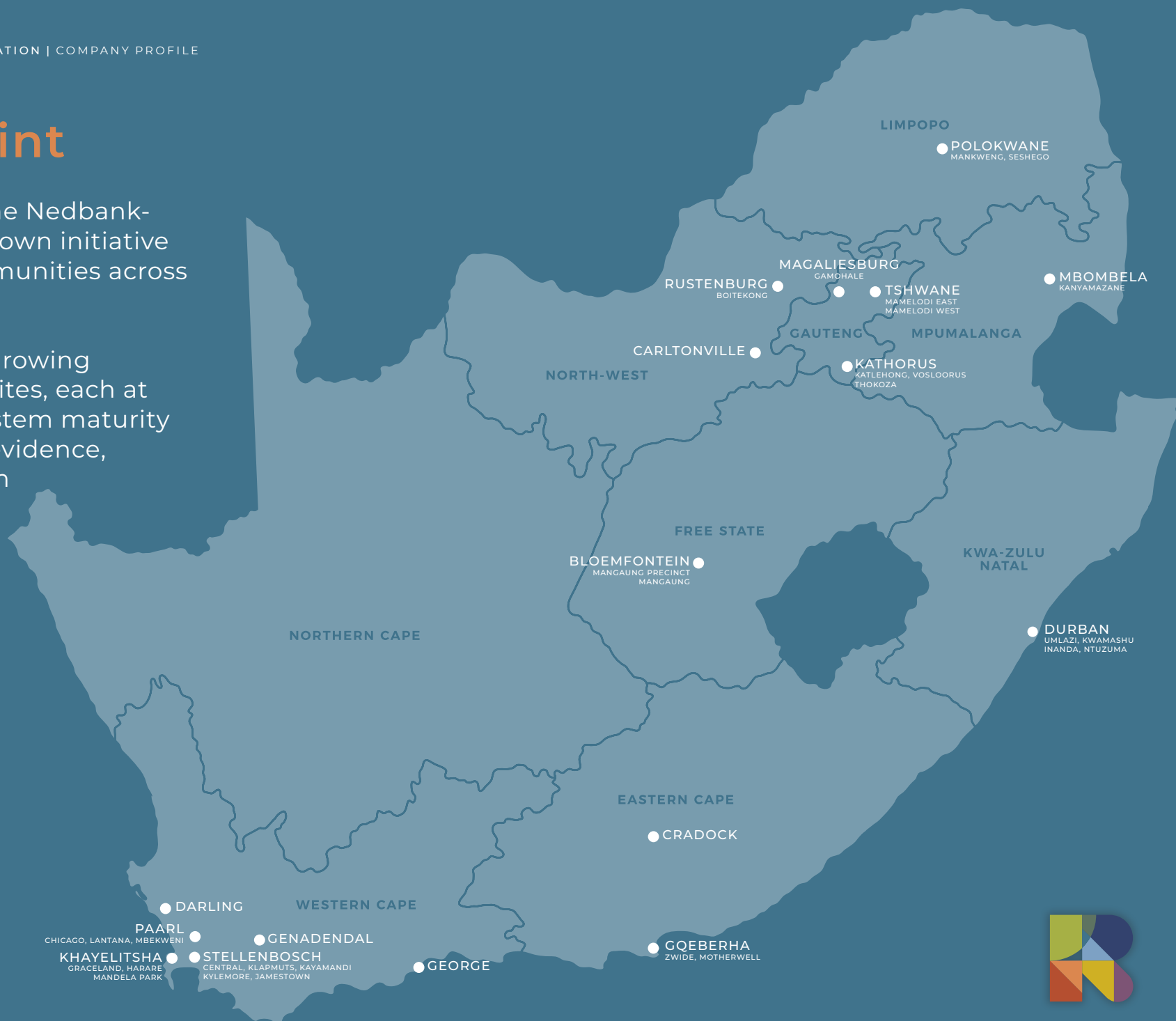
This allows communities, funders and partners to see not only what is happening, but where effort and capital are most likely to unlock sustained progress.



Our footprint

By the end of 2025, the Nedbank-funded Proud of My Town initiative was active in 38 communities across 8 provinces.
